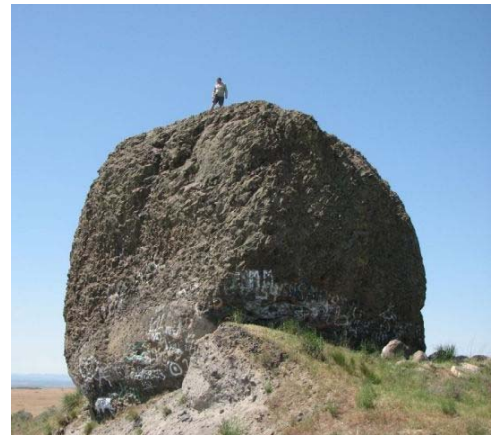
# BOY SCOUT TROOP 626
